Communique – 7 March 2017

The sixth meeting of the Directors General ICT Council was held on Tuesday 7 March 2017 at Dumas House.

Members considered the following matters:

GovNext-ICT Benefits Realisation Management Strategy (BRMS)

The whole-of-government benefits realisation approach is proposed to assist agencies plan their transition into GovNext-ICT and to measure the organisation benefits via GovNext-ICT implementation. Members endorsed the GovNext-ICT Benefits Realisation Management Strategy.

Business Continuity and Disaster Recovery policy update (BCDR)

The ICT Business Continuity and Disaster Recovery (BCDR) Policy has been updated with agencies feedback. Members supported and endorsed the updated policy subject to amendments on timeframe for policy compliance and consideration to the financial impact that may arise due to compliance with the policy.

Digital Service Guide

Members discussed issues around data identity and data sharing between agencies, and agreed that options for data sharing without requiring legislative changes should be explored first.

Key initiatives update

The Council was updated on the status of the GovNext-ICT Program, the review of the whole of government ICT Strategy *Digital WA* and the status of the ICT Renewal and Reform Fund (IRRF).

Next Steps

The next meeting of the Council is scheduled for 13 June 2017.
