

**Business Impact Group and Chief Information Officers Advisory Committee
Communique – 14 February 2017**

The fourth combined meeting of the Business Impact Group and CIO Advisory Committee was held on Tuesday 14 February 2017 at Dumas House.

Members considered the following matters:

GovNext-ICT Benefits Realisation Management Strategy

A whole-of-government benefits realisation approach was proposed to measure the benefits of GovNext-ICT, and to assist agencies plan their transition into the program. The committee was supportive of the approach.

Business Continuity and Disaster Recovery (BCDR) Policy Update

The BCDR policy was updated to link to other policy developments and the Digital WA Strategy. The purpose of the policy is to improve agencies risk management.

Members supported the updated policy with the requirement for agencies to have a plan in place within 12 months of endorsement.

IRRF Building and Wealth Management (BMW) Business Case for Integrated Building Asset Management System

The committee discussed the merit of an Integrated Building Asset Management System across government. While the committee thought the initiative had merit, there was not enough clear information around benefits, demonstrated agency support, or feasibility at this stage. The Department of Finance will undertake a feasibility study with a view to submit at a future meeting.
