

Business Impact Group and Chief Information Officers Advisory Committee Communique – 15 August 2017

The fifth combined meeting of the Business Impact Group and CIO Advisory Committee was held on Tuesday 15 August 2017 at Dumas House.

Members considered the following matters:

Proposal for a Cyber Security Unit

Members supported in-principle a proposal for a whole of government cyber security unit.

Streamlining Justice Architecture

Justice agencies submitted an ICT Renewal and Reform Fund application to capture the current state of architecture (business functions, applications, data and technology) across the justice portfolio. Members endorsed the proposal.

Digital Security Policy

The annual review of the Digital Security Policy was undertaken with members endorsing minor amendments to the Policy.

Machinery of Government Changes

Members discussed the impact of the machinery of government changes and the opportunities it presents to ICT reform.

GovNext-ICT Update

Members noted that agencies are now rolling into the GovNext-ICT contract with early indications showing savings consistent with the business case.

Digital WA Key Performance Indicator Whole of Government Results

Initial results of the whole of government KPI reporting exercise were presented to members for their information. The report and lessons learned will be considered by the Directors General ICT Council at their September meeting.

Update on Website Project Governance Process

An update on agency compliance with the website project governance process was presented to members and was noted.

WA Data Classification Pilot

Members noted a pilot was being undertaken to trial the policy with results to be presented to members shortly.
