

Business Impact Group Communiqué – 13 April 2016

The inaugural meeting of the newly established Business Impact Group was held on Wednesday 13 April 2016 at Dumas House. The Business Impact Group is chaired by the Government Chief Information Officer and comprises of ten business executives from across the public sector.

The Business Impact Group has been established to provide advice to the Directors General ICT Council on the business merits of whole-of-government information and communication technology (ICT) reform initiatives.

The first meeting of the Business Impact Group was a combined meeting with the CIO Advisory Committee. Members discussed a wide range of topics including:

- The WA Government digital services initiative – MyWA; a whole-of-government digital services portal. Stage 1 of the initiative focuses on providing users seamless access to WA government's licensing solutions.
- The merits of an ICT Renewal and Reform Fund submission for a government-only ICT event to be held in October.
- The need for a business realisation plan for the DG ICT Council to ensure that key initiatives are mapped, objectives are clearly understood and progress is tracked.

Next Steps

The next meeting of the Business Impact Group is scheduled for July 2016.
